Bidders are hereby notified that this addendum shall be made a part of the above-named proposal and contract documents.

The following is issued to modify, and/or clarify the proposal and contract documents. These items shall have the same force and effect as the original bid and contract documents, and bids to be submitted on the specified date shall conform with the additions, deletions and revisions as listed herein.

- Item #1:** **Question:** How long before contractor is expected to start work?
Answer: 60 days from award
- Item #2:** **Question:** What is the largest size limb contractor is expected to cut (in diameter)?
Answer: Maximum diameter to be cut shall not exceed 6"
- Item #3:** **Question:** Where is the location of one of the first areas to be power sheared? So Contractor can look at it.
Answer: Northwest Port Charlotte
- Item #4:** **Question:** Can you round bale the mulches material? If so, how long before you would have to remove the baled material from R.O.W.?
Answer: TS-04 A second paragraph. The equipment to be used for mulching shall be designed and built to cut and mulch brush, debris, and small trees to mulch that can be left in place.
