Bidders are hereby notified that this addendum shall be made a part of the above-named proposal and contract documents. The following is issued to modify, and/or clarify the proposal and contract documents. These items shall have the same force and effect as the original bid and contract documents, and bids to be submitted on the specified date shall conform with the additions, deletions and revisions as listed herein.

ITEM #1 QUESTIONS/ANSWERS:

Q1. Who is responsible for tree removal the site contractor or landscape contractor?

A1. The means and methods are up to the awarded Contractor.

Q2. Drawing sheet L-602 show a detail for sumps in poor drainage conditions, will a sump be required for every tree? If not, how many sumps are required? If yes, will there be a perkalation test?

A2. Sumps will be required wherever poor drainage conditions exist. It is impossible to determine where these conditions exist at this time. Once site prep is completed for the signs conditions could be altered due to compaction and construction that could create poor drainage conditions.

Q3. Can the Ametek valve boxes be substituted for Carson valve boxes?

A3. Please bid the project as specified. The awarded Contractor may submit shop drawings for approval as a value engineering proposal.

This addendum is binding and is to be considered as if contained within the original bid documents of Bid No. 2009000345. Bidders are required to acknowledge receipt of this addendum on their bid forms.
